CJ expresses sorrow over passing of former High Court Judge Louis Tong

Chief Justice Andrew Cheung, Chief Justice of the Court of Final Appeal, today

Mr Tong joined the Judiciary as a Temporary Magistrate in 1990 and became a

Magistrate in 1991. He was promoted to Principal Magistrate in 1997 and was appointed

as Chief Magistrate in 1998. In 2000, he was appointed a Judge of the CFI of the High

Court.

"On behalf of the Judiciary, I would like to extend my deepest condolences to his

family," Chief Justice Cheung said.
